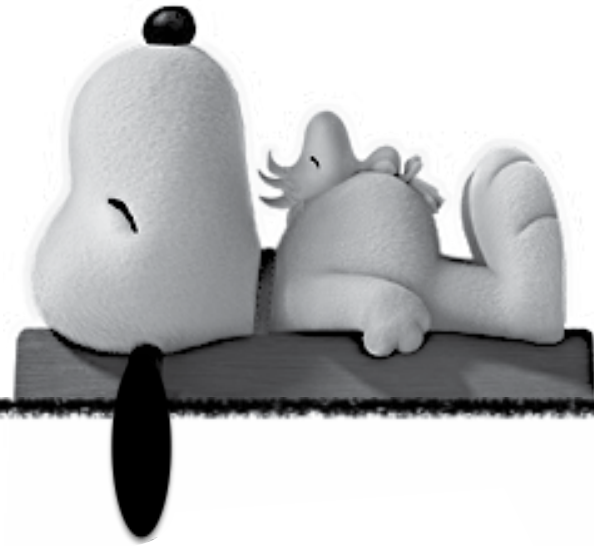

DIRECTOR'S NOTE



Arguably rare is the artist who not only captures hearts and minds with their work, but also establishes their own standalone genre. Endearing and complex characters, charming humor, deceptively biting satire, unique lexicon, recognizable artistic style - all within a simple comic strip telling their stories four panels at a time, drawn and penned by Charles M. Schulz. Schulz's brilliance is that his beloved characters are young children who capture the innocence, simplicity, and warmth of childhood while providing brilliant commentary on adult society and the human experience.

I am not the least bit ashamed to admit that I tear up every Christmas when our family watches the 1965 *A Charlie Brown Christmas*, when Charlie Brown despondently calls out "ISN'T THERE ANYONE - WHO KNOWS WHAT CHRISTMAS IS ALL ABOUT!?" and Linus calls "Lights, please!". Anyone with a heart can then appreciate the peaceful message from Linus, religious and non-religious alike. Linus ends the passage (*brilliantly* voiced by child actor Christopher Shea) with "...and on earth, peace; goodwill to men (*all people*)."



The character of a little boy named Linus, with his trusty blanket, stops a nation in its tracks, one television at a time, to reflect on the intended peace of our existence.

"Peanuts" also gives a good laugh in addition to a tear or two. We find shared experience and companionship in the antics and actions of our young friends, as well as within each character themselves. The playfulness, imagination, and loyalty of Snoopy and Woodstock; the intellect and dependency of Linus; the assertive and know-it-all of Lucy; the sass and whimsy of Sally; the dramatic artist and passion of Schroeder; the noble and proud Pig Pen; and of course, the often despairing but eternally hopeful Charlie Brown.

I think we all have aspects of ourselves that we can identify with in these characters, and that is what makes them so endearing. We also identify these characters in others! We all know a bossy and obnoxious Lucy, who thinks she knows so much that just isn't so. We've all had a crush like Sally has on Linus, or Charlie Brown with the Little Red-haired Girl. We all know a deep "suffering artist" like Schroeder, and we know a Pig Pen! We all know others, and ourselves, have faced the self doubt of a Charlie Brown. Perhaps we all take turns as these characters, if we are honest with ourselves.

Schulz brilliantly balances all of these characters, in which the positive and the negative, the ying and the yang, are equitable enough that *really like* these characters, warts and all. Their faults are ours, as are the strengths. And yet, our children simply enjoy the friendship and kinship with these young characters. Honestly - is there anyone who doesn't like Snoopy!?

Incredibly, when these characters jumped from the page to the stage and screen, they lost nothing of their charm and appeal. If anything, seeing these characters in action further enhanced the memorable aspects of the "Peanuts" gang, again capturing unique lightning in a bottle with the deceptively simplistic music of the brilliant Vince Guiraldi and his trio. Guiraldi's melodies superbly capture the "Peanuts", an absolute master class in unifying characters through music,



similar to how the themes of John Williams so brilliantly evoke their subjects, such as the themes for *Harry Potter*, *Star Wars*, *ET*, *Jaws*, etc. Anyone, anywhere, hears the theme from "Linus and Lucy" and immediately will do their own rendition of a "Peanuts" character dance. Adults and children laugh in delight, together.



At this point, Clark Gesner enters the "Peanuts" picture. In the late 1950s early 1960s, Gesner composed standalone songs for the characters. Upon hearing them, Charles Schulz gave his blessing for these songs to evolve into a musical stage production, which found great success. The musical consists of vignettes evoking the brief, four panel newspaper comic scenes. Each song and scene is a different story within a day in the life of Charlie Brown and his friends. Dialogue and lyrics are drawn from the comics and brought to life onstage.

The goal of a production of *You're a Good Man, Charlie Brown!* should not be to completely re-create the "Peanuts" world in a realistic way; the goal should be to capture the spirit and *joie d vivre* of these characters. Tropes and traits can appear, certainly, but just like the Guiraldi music blends so perfectly with the "Peanuts", the production of this musical should evoke the same smiles and feeling of the "Peanuts" world.

After all, Schulz's "Peanuts" world is our world, a world of imperfect characters that face challenges, setbacks, and tough situations and yet - at the end of the day - we strive to reflect on the wonderful and the beautiful, that bring "Happiness" and peace. May we strive to choose the positive and choose hope, as Charlie Brown is so good at doing. Facing hardships, yet never losing hope, optimism, and caring for others?

To borrow stylistically from Linus: "That's what life is all about, Charlie Brown."

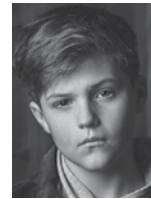
