RADNOR ACTORS WORKSHOP ACTIVITY FEES

This document contains information about the activity fees for students participating in a Radnor Actors Workshop production. The activity fee is different for each production. The fee is also different for students in the cast, students in the stage crew, and students playing in the orchestra.

ACTIVITY FEE INFORMATION FOR THE FALL PLAY

Students who are actors in the fall play cast will pay eighty dollars for their activity fee. The deadline is the last day of September. If the payment of the fee is late, the activity fee for students who are actors in the play is ninety dollars.

Students who are in the fall play stage crew will pay sixty dollars for their activity fee. The deadline is the last day of September. If the payment of the fee is late, the activity fee for students who are in the stage crew is seventy dollars.

Some Fall Plays might be musicals, or might have live musicians playing instruments in an orchestra. Not all Fall Plays will have live musicians in an orchestra. When there is a student orchestra, students who are in the fall play orchestra will pay sixty dollars for their activity fee. The deadline is the last day of September. If the payment of the fee is late, the activity fee for the fall play orchestra is seventy dollars.

ACTIVITY FEE INFORMATION FOR THE SPRING MUSICAL

Students who are actors in the spring musical cast will pay one hundred and five dollars for their activity fee. The deadline for the Spring Musical activity fee is no later than December twentieth. If the payment of the fee is late, the activity fee for students who are actors in the play is one hundred and fifteen dollars.

Students who are in the stage crew spring musical will pay sixty five dollars for their activity fee. The deadline for the Spring Musical activity fee is no later than December twentieth. If the payment of the fee is late, the activity fee for students who are in the stage crew for the spring musical is seventy five dollars.

The spring musical has a live orchestra. Students who are in the spring musical orchestra will pay sixty five dollars for their activity fee. The deadline for the Spring Musical activity fee is no later than December twentieth. If the payment of the fee is late, the activity fee for the spring musical orchestra is seventy five dollars.

ACTIVITY FEE INFORMATION FOR THE SPRING IMPROVISATION SHOW CALLED WHOSE LINE IS IT ANYWAY

Students who are actors in Whose Line Is It Anyway will pay fifty dollars for their activity fee. The deadline for the whose line is it anyway activity fee is no later than the last day of April. If the payment of the fee is late, the activity fee for students who are actors in whose line is it anyway is sixty dollars.

Students who are in the stage crew for Whose Line Is It Anyway will pay forty dollars for their activity fee. The deadline for the Whose Line Is It Anyway activity fee is no later than the last day of April. If the payment of the fee is late, the activity fee for students who are in the stage crew for whose line is it anyway is fifty dollars.

HOW TO PAY THE ACTIVITY FEE

There are three options to pay the activity fee.

The first option is to pay digitally online through a service called My School Bucks. This is an RTSD service. This is a link to the My School Bucks

website. Be sure to use the dropdown menu on the My School Bucks website to select which fee you are paying for. When you are done, please email Mrs. Braunfeld to let her know you paid the fee with My School Bucks. This is a link to email Mrs. Braunfeld.

The second option is to write a check and hand it in to the Main Office at Radnor High School, or place it in the lockbox in the Theatre Classroom 164. The check is payable to RTSD. Write the activity fee and student name in the memo section of the check. Place the check in an envelope. Write on the envelope attention Mrs. Braunfeld, the activity fee you are paying, and the student's name. Seal the envelope. Drop off the sealed envelope with the check to the Radnor High School Main Office, or the student may place it in the lockbox in the Theatre Classroom.

The third option is to write a check and mail it to Radnor High School. The check is payable to RTSD. Write the activity fee and student name in the memo section of the check. Place the check in an envelope. Address the envelope to say "Attention Alexis Braunfeld, RHS Theatre". On the next line write Radnor High School. On the next line write the address of the school, which is 130 King of Prussia Road, Radnor, PA - 19087. Seal the envelope. Put a stamp on the envelope. Mail the envelope with the check in a secure manner.
